## FAMILY ACCOMMODATION FOR SUMMER STAY 2011 ROME

Living in a host family offers a good opportunity to acquire a deeper understanding of Italian culture. By choosing this type of accommodation, students should accept some restrictions and respect certain rules. LDM recommends the family stay to students who are very interested in learning Italian language and to those who are motivated about deepening their knowledge of Italian culture and family structure. On the other hand, LDM does not recommend this type of housing arrangement to those students who want to be independent and free from family rules and restrictions.

Once requests for family stay are received by LDM, the LDM housing coordinators will inform the Program about the Family assignments.

About a week before the class starting date, the school will provide the student with (via e-mail ):

- Family description, family's address, specifying any roommate

Students that stay in families have a **curfew** of 2:30 a.m. each night. If students arrive after this time, families are required to inform the school. The first time a student breaks the curfew, the student is given a warning. The second time a student breaks the curfew, the student is put on probation and the student's home institution will be informed. The third time a student breaks the curfew, the student will be expelled from Lorenzo de' Medici.

Most families do not live in the centre or downtown area and therefore students who select this type of accommodation will have to take the city bus to reach the school. It should also be pointed out that most hosts in Rome are not complete families, but usually divorced or widowed woman. However, it still provides a great experience for a student to practice his/her Italian, eat genuine Italian food, and get to know a real side of the Italian culture. If the family is located more than 30 minutes public transportation from the school, the family will provide to the students a monthly bus/metro pass.

The family stay includes continental breakfast every day (bread, butter, milk, coffee/tea) and dinner 5 times a week with the family. Dinner is served around 8PM. **Meals are provided Monday through Friday.** Skipped meals will not be refunded. Students are not allowed to prepare meals by themselves ( not kitchen use ). Families are required to provide students with food/drink only during breakfast and dinner. So, we suggest students to buy some extra food (fruits, yogurts, orange juices, snacks etc.) to use.

Check-in and check-out dates are specified in the academic calendar of the LDM Programs. Under no circumstance will students be allowed to check in before students' arrival day and/or check out after students' check out day.

### COST

Costs for a student in a single per person for one summer session (June OR July) is Euro 1275. Cost include:

- Accommodation in a single room and half board (breakfast and dinner), as specified above
- Utilities (gas, water, electricity)
- Incoming telephone calls
- Changing of linens and towels, once a week
- Laundry, once a week
- Internet

## RESERVATION PROCEDURE

Once admitted to the LdM Rome Program the student choosing the family stay must mail the following:

- Completed and signed Family Rules and Regulations form
- Personal Profile form
- Detailed flight Itinerary (from place of departure to your final destination).

If you are not arriving by plane to your final destination please let us know which transportation you will use and the approximate time arrival.

- **Students must pay the housing rent balance 30 days BEFORE the class starting date.** The housing coordinator will send an email to the student and/or program about a week before the class starting date with the student's housing assignment.
- **\*\*Please note that all bank charges are to be paid by the student. You must tell you bank this before doing the transfer.\*\***

## CANCELLATION POLICY

- If a student's cancellation is received by LdM 45 days prior to the students' program arrival date, the student will be refunded 90% of the full housing fee.
- If a student's cancellation is received by LdM within the 44 days prior to the students' program arrival date, the student will be refunded 50% of the full housing fee.
- Upon arrival in Rome, if the student wants to leave the assigned family, no refund will be made.
- The student who leaves the family will be considered as an "Independent Housing" student and LdM will be released from any responsibility of finding another housing arrangement for the student

## FAMILY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The **privacy** of the family must be respected at all times. Remember that each family has its own rules and way of life. You are their guest and you ought to maintain a sense of respect and mutual cooperation.
- **Room:** You are not allowed to hang objects (pictures and posters) or stickers of any kind on the walls and/or furniture. Don't move the furniture around.
- **Laundry and cleaning:** These services are available once a week to the students. Depending on the family assigned, students will have access to the family laundry machine, or the family will do the wash for the students (students may do one wash load). Extra loads will have to be paid by the student directly to the family. You should tidy up your room when you and your host family have settled on a cleaning day.
- **Meals/Kitchen use:**  
Breakfast time is limited from 7:00-10:30 a.m. and dinner is served around 8:00 p.m. Meals are provided 5 days a week (Monday to Friday).  
You should always inform your family if you plan to be late for or skip dinner and if you are planning not to be home for one or more days. If anything happens to you, call your family to inform them that you are not coming home so that they will not wait for you. You will not be refunded any money for the meals that you skip. Kitchen use is not available: You are not allowed to prepare meals by yourself. Therefore, we suggest that students buy extra food for lunch during the week and for meals for the weekends.
- **Utilities** are included in the cost. Water: avoid monopolizing the bathroom and/or taking very long showers (**Tip:** get in and get wet, turn the water off, soap up, shampoo, shave, turn the water back on and rinse off. If everybody does this, think about how much water could be conserved!), as other family members might be waiting for you to finish. Electricity: turn off the lights you are not using. Heater: don't open the windows if the heater is on. The family will inform the students regarding the time and the temperature the heater will be on. Students are not allowed to touch, move or change the thermostat.
- **Telephone use:** tell your relatives and friends to avoid calling after 10:00 p.m. unless it is very urgent. Try not to stay on the phone for a long time, as other family members might need to make or receive phone calls. You should pay for all the calls that you make on the family phone directly to the family. In Italy, local and long-distance calls are expensive. For international calls, we suggest that you buy an international calling card (US calling cards are a more affordable way to make phone calls to the US). Or you may want to rent a cell phone for your entire stay at any of the cell phone providers located in your city.
- **Noises and damages:** Disturbing noises are not permitted at any time.  
The student is completely responsible to pay for the cost of all damages. This should be paid directly to the family during the student's stay.
- **Guests:** No parties are allowed. If you want to introduce your real family or some friends to your host family ask them when would be a good time to meet them. It is not considered polite to bring someone over without asking permission first. Guest are not allowed to have breakfast or dinner with your host family.  
Guest can sleep at your host family only if there's a spot available, if your host family agrees and paying for this service. They have to pay directly to the family who will inform them about the cost per day.
- Each family is different. If there is a **problem** with the family, please try to work it out directly with them. If this is not possible, talk with your on-site advisor or housing coordinator.
- Upon arrival in Italy, if the student wants to leave the assigned family, no refund will be made. The student who leaves the family will be considered as an "Independent Housing" student and LdM will be released from any responsibility of finding another housing arrangement for the student.
- Signing below means acceptance of the **Family Cancellation Policy**, and that the student is willing to pay the designated penalty in accordance with the Cancellation policy in case of a cancellation.
