## *Academic Guidelines*

The Paris American Academy strives to create an environnement conducive to the finest level of teaching possible. Students are expected to make every effort to profit from this opportunity. To maintain academic, artistic and professional standards, the school must insist upon certain codes of scholastic behavior and procedure.

### ■ ATTENDANCE :

Punctuality and attendance are very important. There is an attendance sheet for each class. Absences will decrease your grades. Students are responsible for catching up on all relevant course work missed during any absence.

Any subject withdrawal must be authorized by the Administration, without which an automatic subject failure will incur. Withdrawal from compulsory subjects could place your certificate in jeopardy.

### ■ BUILDING :

Students must bring the materials necessary for every course. Students must respect the school's materials and the materials of other students. The school does not take any responsibility for any personal effects left in classrooms. It is not permitted to eat in the classrooms. For health and security reasons, it is forbidden to smoke in the school.

### ■ ASSIGNMENTS :

All work demanded must be submitted on the set date. A lack of attendance will result in students appearing before the Administration to determine the students future attendance at the Academy.

### ■ EVALUATION AND ASSESSMENT :

The Academic Year is divided into 2 semesters. Student work will assessed continually and at the end of each trimester. Assessment may take the forms of weekly exercices, oral and written assignments, portfolios and the construction of objects or garments. The different criteria used to assess grades may include areas such as participation and motivation, creativity and individuality, spirit of initiative and ability to communicate. Students risk losing marks or failing if they miss classes or fail to submit their homework for assessment. Students who are worried about their progress and class marks must make appointments with their professor to discuss these problems. Any student who is still unsatisfied should make an appointment with a member of the administration.

### ■ STUDENT INVOLVMENT :

PAA provides plenty of opportunity for students to be involved in many events, activities, and issues related to the school. For disseminating relevant information a notice board will be found in the Pavillon. Students are responsible for reading all notices.


